25 better respond to budget matters and other issues,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL  
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

31 That the House Interim Committee on Aging, Children and Youth,  
32 Legislative and Military Affairs is requested to study the need for annual  
33 sessions of the General Assembly and, if appropriate, to develop a proposed  
34 constitutional amendment providing for annual sessions.
