20	WHEREAS, It is unclear the amount of excess property owned by state
21	agencies in Arkansas; and

23	WHEREAS, It is necessary for the Arkansas General Assembly to know the
24 25	amount of excess property belonging to the state in order to better serve the
25 24	people of Arkansas; and
26 27	WHEREAS, The excess property could be put to better use if liquidated
28	and placed in a trust fund to serve the education needs of the people of
29	Arkansas.

31	NOW THEREFORE,
32	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
33	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

35	That the House Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
36	Affairs study the amount of excess property belonging to the state and to

prepare a recommendation to the Legislative Council by July 1, 2000 which may include a recommendation that the excess property be placed in an education trust fund. State agencies shall assist the House Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs in assessing the excess property owned by the state.
