WHEREAS, the Arkansas School for the Blind offers el ementary and secondary education progran® for the visually-impaired youth of Arkansas from its beautifully located campus on the bl uffs high above the Arkansas River in the heart of Little Rock, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas School for the Blind is entering its third cent ury of service to the people of Arkansas, and it is important that all government institutions are sensitive to the feel ings of its citizens, regardless of vi sual acuity, and a name change for such an institution to Ozark Poi nt migh well serve it and the needs of all citizens of Arkansas,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES OF THE EI GHTY- SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the House Interim Comittee on Education is requested to conduct a study of the Arkansas School for the Blind, and determine if there is a need to change the name to make it better serve the needs of all people in Arkansas, and that the committee report their recommendations, incl udi ng any proposed I egi slation, to the Eighty-third General Assembly.
