21 WHEREAS, since 1993, Arkansas' logging and forestry communities have
22 raised more than seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for
23 Arkansas Children's Hospital; and

25 WHEREAS, these funds support the newly created "Arkansas Log-a-Load-for-
26 Kids Endowed Chair of Cardiovascular Surgery" at Arkansas Children's Hospital;

29 WHEREAS, the logging and forestry communities not only work hard to take
30 care of our state's most renewable resource, its forests, but also to take
31 care of the state's most precious resource, its children; and

33 WHEREAS, the 1998 Arkansas Log-a-Load-for-Kids was the third (3rd)
34 highest fundraising campaign in the national Log-a-Load-for-Kids program; and

36 WHEREAS, the Log-a-Load-for-Kids campaign brings together communities

1 throughout the state for a common purpose, to help make miracles happen for
2 the patients and families who pass through the doors of Arkansas Children's
3 Hospital; and

5 WHEREAS, Arkansas' logging and forestry communities are deserving of
6 public commendation and appreciation,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
