## Subtitle

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15 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1999-2001  
17 BIENNIUM. "

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
23 the Office of the Governor for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum  
24 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
25 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
26 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
27 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
28 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
29 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
32 successor.

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29 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
30 Office of the Governor for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum  
31 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
32 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary  
33 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those  
34 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,  
35 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the Governor for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - TEA INDEPENDENT EVALUATOR. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Office of the Governor - TEA Independent Evaluator for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

1 PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of appropriation provided in this Act,  
2 excluding Regular Salaries, which remains at the close of the fiscal year  
3 ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000, shall be transferred forward and made available for  
4 the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001.

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6 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by  
7 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
8 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions  
9 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures  
10 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and  
11 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
12 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
13 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
14 with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
23 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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29 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
30 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
31 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
32 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
33 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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35 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
36 this act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
