19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 15, Subchapter 6 is amended
22 by adding the following new language:

23 "§ 20-15-606 (a) Any person who has served, is now serving, or serves
24 in the future as a member of the State Kidney Disease Commission, as
25 established by A.C.A. §§ 20-15-601 through 20-15-605, or its predecessor
26 commissions, and who has served or serves twenty-four (24) years as a member
27 of the commission, or its predecessor commissions, shall be eligible to be
28 known and designated as a 'Commissioner Emeritus' if the Governor so appoints.

29 (b) A commissioner emeritus shall serve as a member of the State Kidney
30 Disease Commission for the remainder of his or her life and shall be notified
31 of all commission meetings, shall be eligible to vote, and shall be entitled
32 to the same expenses and other allowances for attending commission meetings as
33 is provided by law for other commission members.

34 (c) The Governor shall cause an appropriate commission to be prepared
35 and issued to each commissioner emeritus of the State Kidney Disease
36 Commission. The commissioner emeritus shall file the commission with the

1 Secretary of State and take the official oath of office before entering upon
2 his duties as a commissioner emeritus of the commission."

3
4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7
8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 Act are declared to be severable.

13
14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
15 hereby repealed.
