5	appointed by the Governor from a list of names submitted by the Arkansas
6	Association of Educational Administrators. The first three (3) citizen
7	members shall serve staggered terms, determined by lot so that one (1) serves
8	a one (1) year term, one (1) serves a two (2) year term, and the other serves
9	a three (3) year term. Successors shall serve three (3) year terms;
10	(v) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor from
11	a list of names submitted by the Arkansas Association of Educational
12	Administrators who are knowledgeable in the various aspects of the student and
13	instruction application. Such members shall serve staggered terms determined
14	by lot so that one (1) serves a one (1) year term, one (1) serves a two (2)
15	year term, and the other serves a three (3) year term. Successors shall serve
16	three (3) year terms.
17	(B) The members of the Public School System Computer
18	Network Advisory Council Public Education Technology Advisory Board shall
19	serve without pay and represent $\underline{\text{the needs and interests of}}$ citizens and users
20	of the network and data educational technology. The members shall be
21	appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Director of the Department of
22	Education. The Director of the Department of Education President of the
23	Arkansas Science and Technology Authority shall be designated as chairman of
24	the <u>Public School System Computer Network Advisory Council.</u> <u>Public Education</u>
25	Technology Advisory Board. The board shall be convened at the call of the
26	chair. The Department of Education and the Department of Information Systems
27	shall provide appropriate staff support.
28	(2) In addition to providing assistance and coordination, the The
29	council board may also assist and offer advice regarding the purchase or lease
30	of equipment utilized in the computer network system may create such advisory
31	committees as it may deem necessary to assist it in carrying out its
32	<u>functions</u> . <u>The memberships of these advisory committees may include members</u>
33	of the board and other persons drawn from various sources, all of whom shall
34	serve at the pleasure of the board. Members of the advisory committees shall
35	serve without compensation for their membership on the committees.
36	(3) The heard shall issue an annual report on the condition of

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5	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature			
6	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code			
7	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to			
10	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect			
11	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without			
12	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this			
13	act are declared to be severable.			
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15	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are			
16	hereby repealed.			
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
