9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-16-804 (b) TO
10 PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MUST BE FIFTEEN (15) YEARS OLD
11 BEFORE HE OR SHE MAY OBTAIN A HARDSHIP WAIVER FOR A
12 DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MUST BE
16 FIFTEEN (15) YEARS OLD BEFORE HE OR SHE
17 MAY OBTAIN A HARDSHIP WAIVER FOR A

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-16-804 (b) is amended to read as follows:

23 "(b)(1) The office may either issue a special restricted license or may
24 set forth such restrictions upon the usual license form.

25 (2) All licensees under the age of sixteen (16) years shall be
26 restricted to operation of a motor vehicle, motorcycles and motor-driven
27 cycles excepted, only while accompanied by a licensed driver, eighteen (18)
28 years of age or older, who has had at least one (1) year of driving
29 experience, unless ~~otherwise determined by the office~~ grants a hardship waiver
30 for a person fifteen (15) years of age."
31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
35

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 Act are declared to be severable.

5
6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
7 hereby repealed.
