23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:			
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25	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY ALCOHOL SAFETY. There is hereby			
26	appropriated, to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department, to			
27	be payable from the Highway Safety Special Fund, for grants to communities of			
28	the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department - Community Alcohol			
29	Safety which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 2 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal
- 3 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State
- 4 Treasurer the sum of eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) from the State
- 5 Administration of Justice Fund to the Highway Safety Special Fund to provide
- 6 funds for the appropriation provided herein.

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SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 8 9 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 10 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 11 12 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 13 14 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 16 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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1	SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with		
2	this act are hereby repealed.		
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4	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the		
5	Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly		
6	for the operations of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department		
7	are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas State		
8	Highway and Transportation Department to continue to provide essential		
9	governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the		
10	necessary monies for the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department		
11	to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act		
12	could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of		
13	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to		
14	exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the		
15	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and		
16	after the date of its passage and approval.		
17	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
18	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
19	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
20	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the		
21	<u>veto.</u>		
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
