| 12 | Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly   |

| 14 | Disbursing Officer are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the |
| 15 | Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to  |
| 16 | provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will |
| 17 | provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration |
| 18 | - Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the       |
| 19 | effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper        |
| 20 | administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,   |
| 21 | an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the |
| 22 | immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in     |
| 23 | full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.    |
