## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR INCREASES IN  
10 ARKANSAS CONTRIBUTIONS TO VARIOUS INTERSTATE  
11 ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
12 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH SHALL BE  
13 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
14 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1358 OF 1997; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES."

17 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
26

27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - INTERSTATE ORGANIZATIONS. There is hereby  
28 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
29 Officer, to be payable from the State General Services Fund Account for  
30 increases in Arkansas' contribution to various interstate organizations,  
31 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in  
32 Section 11 of Act 1358 of 1997, the following:

7 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
 9 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal  
 10 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State  
 11 Treasurer the sum of six thousand one hundred seven dollars (\$6,107) from the  
 12 General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the State General Services Fund  
 13 Account to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein.

14

15 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 16 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 17 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 18 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 32 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
 36 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
3 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
4 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
5 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
6 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

7  
8 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
9 this act are hereby repealed.

10  
11 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
12 Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly  
13 for the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration -  
14 Disbursing Officer are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the  
15 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to  
16 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will  
17 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration  
18 - Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the  
19 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
20 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
21 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
22 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
23 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

24 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
25 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
26 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
27 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
28 the veto.
