## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 20, CHAPTER 76, SUBCHAPTER 3, TO GRANT AUTHORI TY TO THE DI RECTOR OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR SOCI AL SECURI TY ADM NI STRATI ON DI SABI LI TY DETERM NATI ON, OR COUNSEL FOR THE AGENCY, TO I SSUE SUBPOENAS TO ASSI ST I NVESTI GATI ONS RELATI NG TO PUBLI C ASSI STANCE BENEFI TS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"TO AUTHORI ZE THE OFFI CE OF THE DI RECTOR FOR SOCI AL SECURI TY ADM NI STRATI ON DI SABI LITY DETERM NATI ON, OR COUNSEL FOR THE AGENCY, TO I SSUE ADM NI STRATI VE SUBPOENAS ASSI STI NG I NVESTI GATONS RELATI NG TO PUBLI C ASSI STANCE BENEFI TS. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 76, Subchapter 3 is amended to add the following new section:
"20-76-306. Use of subpoenas in hearings on benefit determinations.
(a) The Director of the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, or counsel for the agency, is authorized to require the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, records, or ot her documents through the issuance of subpoenas when the testimony or information is necessary to adequatel $y$ present the position of the State Department for Social Security Administration Di sability Determination when making fair hearing determinations or conducting

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i nvesti gati ons rel ating to publ ic assi stance benefits.
    (b) Subpoenas issued pursuant to the authority of the Director of the
State Department for Social Security Admi ni strati on Di sability Determinnati on
shall be substantially in the following form
'The State of Arkansas to the Sheriff of .............................County: You are
commanded to subpoena (name), (address) to appear at................on (dat e) at
(time), and testify and/ or produce the following documents, to
wi t: .............................in a matter of (styl e of proceeding).
W TNESS my hand on (dat e).
(Si gnat ure of Di rect or or agency counsel ).'"
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SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ his Act of a general and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revisi on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the inval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of I aws in conflict with this Act are hereby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is her eby found and deter med by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly, that existing law hi nders the ability of the State Department for Social Security Administration Di sability Det ermination to conduct investigations into benefit determination and benefit fraud; and any del ay in the effective date of this act could cause harmto the St at of Arkansas. Ther ef ore, an emer gency is decl ared to exi st and this act bei ng i mredi at el $y$ necessary for the preservati on of the publ ic peace, heal $t h$ and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during whi ch the Gover nor
may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the vet o is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
