## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
10 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS TECH  
11 UNIVERSITY WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION  
12 TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 723 OF 1997; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY  
17 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION. "

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
23 Tech University the following maximum number of regular employees which shall  
24 be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of  
25 Act 723 of 1997 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
30 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
31 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
32 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - GENERAL REVENUE - SUPPLEMENTAL. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Tech University, to be payable from the Arkansas Tech University Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Tech University which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 5 of Act 723 of 1997, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and

1 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as  
 2 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said  
 3 funds.

4  
 5 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
 12 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13  
 14 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
 16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

17  
 18 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
 19 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
 20 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
 21 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
 22 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

23  
 24 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
 25 this act are hereby repealed.

26  
 27 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
 28 Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly  
 29 for the operations of the Arkansas Tech University are, due to unforeseen  
 30 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Tech University to continue to  
 31 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will  
 32 provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Tech University to continue such  
 33 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work  
 34 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
 35 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
 36 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

1 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of  
2 its passage and approval.

3 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
4 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
5 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
6 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the  
7 veto.
