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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - CODE REVISION FUND. There is hereby
24 established for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 1999-2001
25 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
26 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
27 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
28 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
29 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
30 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
31 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
32 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
33 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - CODE REVISION FUND. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Code Revision Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries

19 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 20 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 1999-2001 biennium, the
 21 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 22 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four
 23 (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 24 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 25 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

27 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 28 to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the State General
 29 Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 30 Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30,
 31 2001, the following:

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SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the

1 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
4 this act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
7 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
8 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
9 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
