13 COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-4-409(c) is amended to read as follows:

25 "(c) The ~~Department of~~ Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology  
26 Commission is hereby authorized to promulgate such rules and regulations as  
27 are necessary to administer the fees, rates, tolls, or charges for services  
28 established by this section. and The Arkansas Department of Environmental  
29 Quality is directed to ~~prescribe and~~ collect such fees, rates, tolls, or  
30 charges for the services delivered by the ~~Department~~ department of Pollution  
31 Control and Ecology in such manner as may be necessary to support this program  
32 as directed by the Governor and the General Assembly."

33  
34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
