 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - ORIENTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, to be used for payment of per diem and mileage of members of the Arkansas Senate who attend the Biennial Senate Orientation program held prior to the convening of the 2001 Regular Session of the General Assembly, the sum of\$10,000.

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION AND CARRYOVER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund or the State Central Services Fund, whichever is appropriate, for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the balance of the appropriations enacted by the Eighty-second General Assembly to defray the expenses of the Arkansas Senate of the Eighty-second General Assembly, Item (23) of Section 1 of Act 3 of 1997 and Sections 2, 4, 6 and 9 of Act 375 of

1	1997, in a sum in the aggregate not to exceed\$1,900,000.
3	SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

28	If the Senate Efficiency Committee and the Senate Fiscal Officer, subject to
29	the approval of the Arkansas Senate, should determine that any item or portion
30	thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such
31	purpose, the Senate Fiscal Officer may certify such fact to the State Auditor
32	and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made from one item to

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35	SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SENATE

- 1 EMPLOYEES. The Senate Efficiency Committee may, at its discretion and subject
- 2 <u>to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, employ, transfer or discharge Arkansas</u>
- 3 Senate employees if it is determined by the committee to be in the best
- 4 <u>interest of the Arkansas Senate</u>. The actual salaries to be paid to employees
- 5 <u>of the Arkansas Senate shall be determined by the Senate Efficiency Committee</u>
- 6 <u>within the funds, appropriations and maximum annual salaries as may be</u>
- 7 available.

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9 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 16 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 14. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 15. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 16. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
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
