8 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

9 "AN ACT TO ALLOW ARKANSAS BREWERIES TO SELL BEER UNDER
10 THE SAME CIRCUMSTANCES AS ARKANSAS WINERIES ARE
11 PERMITTED TO SELL ARKANSAS WINE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES. "

14 **Subtitle**

15 "AN ACT TO ALLOW ARKANSAS BREWERIES TO
16 SELL BEER UNDER THE SAME CIRCUMSTANCES
17 AS ARKANSAS WINERIES ARE PERMITTED TO
18 SELL ARKANSAS WINE. "

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Title 3, Chapter 5, Subchapter 2 of the Arkansas Code is
24 amended to add the following section to be appropriately numbered by the
25 Arkansas Code Revision Commission:

26 "The brewery may sell to the consumer at the brewery in lots of less
27 than sixteen (16) gallons."
28

29 SECTION 2. Title 3, Chapter 5, Subchapter 2 of the Arkansas Code is
30 amended to add the following section to be appropriately numbered by the
31 Arkansas Code Revision Commission:

32 The Alcohol Beverage Control Board is hereby authorized to promulgate
33 reasonable rules and regulations for the on-premises sale with foods, and off-
34 premises package sale, labeling, and identification, of beer sold at beer
35 outlets maintained on the premises and operated in connection with a brewery
36 in this state, and such regulations shall include the following minimum

1 requirements:

2 (1) The brewery shall provide tours through their facilities;

3 (2) Only sealed containers may be removed from the brewery
4 premises."

5

6 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
7 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
8 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
