## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A RESTRICTED LIFETIME LICENSE FOR  
11 BOILER INSPECTORS, OPERATORS, SELLERS, INSTALLERS, AND  
12 REPAIRMEN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A RESTRICTED  
16 LIFETIME LICENSE FOR BOILER INSPECTORS,  
17 OPERATORS, SELLERS, INSTALLERS, AND  
18 REPAIRMEN."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 23, Subchapter 4 is amended  
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 "20-23-406. Restricted Lifetime License Or Certificate Of Competency  
26 And Commission.

27 (a)(1) Upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65) or any time thereafter,  
28 any person who has been a boiler inspector for not less than twelve (12) years  
29 may apply for a restricted lifetime boiler inspector's certificate of  
30 competency and commission. The certificate of competency and commission shall  
31 be issued upon satisfactory proof of age and upon payment of a fee prescribed  
32 by the department.

33 (2) Upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65) or any time  
34 thereafter, any person who has been a boiler operator for not less than twelve  
35 (12) years may apply for a restricted lifetime boiler operator's license.  
36 This license shall be issued upon satisfactory proof of age and upon payment

1 of a fee prescribed by the department.

2 (3) Upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65) or any time  
 3 thereafter, any person who has been engaged in the sale or installation of  
 4 boilers, unfired pressure vessels, or hot water storage containers or pressure  
 5 pip ing for not less than twelve (12) years may apply for a restricted lifetime  
 6 license. This license shall be issued upon satisfactory proof of age and upon  
 7 payment of a fee prescribed by the department.

8 (4) Upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65) or any time  
 9 thereafter, any person who has been engaged in the repair of boilers or  
 10 unfired pressure vessels for not less than twelve (12) years may apply for a  
 11 restricted lifetime license. This license shall be issued upon satisfactory  
 12 proof of age and upon payment of a fee prescribed by the department.

13 (b) The Department of Labor shall promulgate rules and regulations  
 14 necessary to carry out the provisions of this section."

15  
 16 SECTION 2. If another act of the 1999 Regular Session of the General  
 17 Assembly adds a new section of the Arkansas Code having the same number as the  
 18 section added by this act, the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall  
 19 renumber the section added by this act.

20  
 21 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
 22 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
 23 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

24  
 25 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
 26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
 27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
 28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
 29 act are declared to be severable.

30  
 31 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
 32 hereby repealed.
