13 RESPONSE FUND CODIFIED IN ARKANSAS CODE 8-7-410; AND  
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23  
24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-27-1002 is amended to read as follows:  
25 "20-27-1002. Penalties.

26 Any person who violates any provision of this subchapter or commits any  
27 unlawful act thereunder or who violates any regulation or order of the  
28 ~~commission~~ Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission shall be subject  
29 to the penalty provisions provided in the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution  
30 Control Act, as amended, § 8-4-103. All moneys collected as civil penalties  
31 shall be deposited in the Emergency Response Fund as provided by § 8-7-  
32 410(b)(1). "

33  
34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
