Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 25 26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999, except 28 for Section 17 and Section 18 which shall be in full force and effect from and 29 after the date of passage and approval of this act. 30 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 31 32 33 34 35 36
