OF EDUCATION TO 21 22 PAY FULL TUITION AND INCENTIVE BONUSES." 23 24 25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-17-413 is amended to read as follows: 27 28 "6-17-413. NBPTS certification funding. 29 (a) (1) The State Department of Education shall pay one-half (1/2) the full amount of the NBPTS participation fee and provide, if determined to be 30 31 necessary by the State Department of Education, substitute pay for a maximum of three (3) days of approved paid leave for teachers participating in the 32 NBPTS program. A teacher shall have completed at least three (3) years 33 34 teaching in the Arkansas public school system before applying for NBPTS 35 assistance under this section and § 6-17-412, and shall not have previously received state funding for participation in any certification area in the 36

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- 1 NBPTS program.
- 2 (2) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules and
- 3 regulations for the selection process of teacher participants in the NBPTS
- 4 program. The number of teacher participants each year will be determined by
- 5 the amount of funding available for the program.
- 6 (3) The Department of Education shall pay any selected teacher
- 7 participant who successfully completes the national board certification
- 8 process and receives NBPTS certification and is employed in a local public
- 9 school district an incentive bonus of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) upon
- 10 receiving the NBPTS certification and a two thousand dollar (\$2,000) bonus for
- 11 every year for the life of the NBPTS certificate; provided, also, that those
- 12 <u>teachers who began participating in the NBPTS program on and after August 1,</u>
- 13 1997, shall be eligible for payment of this bonus upon receipt of NBPTS
- 14 certification. Any nationally board certified teacher who moves into the
- 15 state and teaches in a public school district shall be eligible for the two
- 16 thousand dollar (\$2,000) bonus for every year for the life of the NBPTS
- 17 certificate.
- 18 <u>(4) The State Board of Education is authorized to promulgate</u>
- 19 <u>rules and regulations to establish a support program for teachers selected to</u>
- 20 participate in the NBPTS program.
- 21 (b)(1) A teacher who receives state moneys for the NBPTS participation
- 22 fee, but who does not complete the certification process within three (3)
- 23 years after the teacher's entry into the NBPTS certification program or who
- 24 becomes NBPTS certified but does not teach in the Arkansas public school
- 25 system for two (2) continuous school years after receiving the NBPTS
- 26 certification, shall repay the state Department of Education the amount it
- 27 contributed to the NBPTS participation fee and the total amount it contributed
- 28 to any yearly bonus.
- 29 (1)(2) Repayment of moneys contributed by the state Department of
- 30 Education are not required if, due to the death or disability of the teacher
- 31 or other extenuating circumstances as may be recognized by the State Board of
- 32 Education, the teacher does not complete the NBPTS certification process or
- 33 does not teach in the Arkansas public school system for two (2) continuous
- 34 school years after completing the NBPTS certification process due to the death
- 35 or disability of the teacher or other extenuating circumstances as may be
- 36 recognized by the State Board of Education.

1	(c) Provisions of this section and § 6-17-412 shall apply only to the
2	extent that funds are appropriated to the Department of Education to pay for
3	these provisions."
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5	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
6	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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9	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13	act are declared to be severable.
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15	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16	hereby repealed.
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
