27 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORMS. 29 After seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, State Building 30 Services may furnish uniforms for Building Maintenance/Operations personnel 31 listed as classified positions in Section 3 and Section 7 <u>6</u> herein, who are 32 directly responsible for the maintenance and operation of all State Building 33 Services' owned buildings.

35 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

9 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 16 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18 SECTION 15. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 19 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 20 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

22 SECTION 16. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application 23 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall 24 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given 25 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 26 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

28 SECTION 17. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 29 this act are hereby repealed.

31 SECTION 18. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is hereby found and determined by the 32 <u>Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas</u> 33 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that 34 <u>the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of</u> 35 <u>the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in</u> 36 <u>the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective</u>

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
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
