23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-17-1503 is amended to read as follows:

25	This subchapter is not a teacher tenure law in that it does not confer			
26	lifetime appointment nor prevent discharge of teachers for any cause which is			
27	not arbitrary, capricious, or discriminatory. A nonrenewal, termination,
