### For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME SHALL BE  
IN EFFECT IN ARKANSAS YEAR-ROUND; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES. "

### Subtitle

"TO PROVIDE THAT DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME  
SHALL BE IN EFFECT IN ARKANSAS YEAR-  
ROUND. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Beginning July 1, 2001, daylight savings time shall remain  
in effect year-round in the State of Arkansas.

SECTION 2. This act constitutes an election by the State of Arkansas to  
be exempted from those provisions of the Uniform Time Act, Public Law 89-387,  
relating to Daylight Saving Time.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
