2	completed the continuing education requirements for the licensing year		
3	following the year in which first licensed in Arkansas;

6	related subjects and otherwise comply with the minimum requirements of this		
7	subchapter, and further provided that evidence of such compliance satisfactory

13	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-42-502(a)(2) is amended to read:		
14	"(2) The commission may identify \underline{a} specific \underline{topic} or \underline{topics} of not more		
15	than one (1) hour to be included in continuing education courses the six (6)		
16	classroom hour annual continuing education requirement."

18	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
19	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
20	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		
21			
22	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
23	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
24	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
25	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
26	act are declared to be severable.

28	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
29	hereby repealed.
