Arkansas Code § 24-10-505, as amended by Act 1011 of 1997, is amended to read as follows: 34 35 "24-10-505. Public safety service with two other Arkansas systems. [As 36 amended by Acts 1997, No. 1011.]

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1 (a) (1) 'Public safety service', for the purpose of this section, means 2 paid service as a police officer, law enforcement officer, or fire fighter 3 with an Arkansas state or local government agency, department, or institution which is covered by a related system for retirement purposes. Provided, 4 however, nothing in this section shall entitle a position listed herein to 5 public safety credit in the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System 6 7 unless the position is defined as 'public safety member' in § 24-3-102(5).; [si c] 8 (2) 'Related system', for the purpose of this section, means any 9 of three (3) four (4) retirement systems: the Arkansas Local Police and Fire 10 Retirement System, the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, or the 11 12 State Police Retirement System, or the Teacher Retirement System. (b) Upon termination of public safety service with all Arkansas 13 14 governmental units, a public safety employee whose public safety service was covered at different times by more than one (1) related system shall receive 15 retirement benefits based upon public safety service covered by a related 16 17 system if the person has reached age sixty-two (62) years of age or older and 18 has total public safety service credit with all related systems of at least 19 ten (10) years or if the total of public safety service credit with all 20 related systems is at least twenty (20) years, provided the provisions of § 24-3-301(b) are not used to meet this total service requirement. The minimum 21 22 service requirements for an age and service benefit and for vesting shall then be considered to be satisfied for each related system. 23 24 (c)(b) The benefit payable by each related system shall be based upon 25 the service credit with that system, the benefit program the related system had in effect at the time the member terminated service covered by the related 26 27 system, and his service and pay covered by the related system while the service was being rendered. 28 29 (c) During any period that a person is employed in a position covered by a related system, that employee is ineligible to receive a refund of 30 accumulated contributions from any related retirement system in which that 31 employee has service credits and accumulated contributions standing in his 32 account. Accumulated contributions may only be refunded when the employee 33 34 terminates all employment covered by a related system and does not have, in 35 the aggregate, sufficient years of credited service to be eligible for an age

and service benefit from any of the related retirement systems."

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-10-613(b), regarding the disposition of accumulated member contributions for the Local Police and Fire Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:

"(b) In the event a member ceases to be a member, other than by death, before the date he becomes entitled to retire with vested to receive an annuity payable by the system, he shall be paid, upon his written application filed with the board, the accumulated contributions standing to his credit in the members' deposit account."

- SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-10-611(a), regarding the termination of covered employment under the Local Police and Fire Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:
- "(a) A member who terminates covered employment before attaining his normal retirement age, for a reason other than death, early retirement, or disability retirement, shall be entitled to an annuity computed in accordance with the provisions of this section, as it provides at the time of the last termination of covered employment, subject to the member's satisfying all of the following conditions:
 - (1) The member has five (5) years of credited service;

1	(2) The member does not withdraw his accumulated contributions
2	from the members' deposit account;
3	(3)(2) The member lives to his annuity starting date;
4	(4) (3) The member makes written application for retirement and
5	payment of the annuity to the system on or after the date which is six (6)
6	months before the date he attains his normal retirement age; and
7	$\frac{(5)}{(4)}$ The annuity starting date shall be the first day of the
8	calendar month next following the later of:
9	(A) The date the member attains his normal retirement age;

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14	SECTION 6. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
15	implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's
16	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year
17	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
18	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial
19	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years
20	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than
21	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.
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23	SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
24	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
25	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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27	SECTION 8. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
28	any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
29	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
30	the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
31	act are declared to be severable.
