# For An Act To Be Entitled <br> "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-106 RELATI NG TO RUNOFF ELECTI ONS FOR COUNTY AND MUNI CI PAL OFFI CERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. " 

## Subtitle

"TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-106 RELATI NG TO RUNOFF ELECTI ONS FOR COUNTY AND MUNI Cl PAL OFFI CERS. "

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-106(a) is amended to read as follows:
"(a) Whenever there are more than two (2) candi dates for el ection to any county el ected office, including the of fice of justice of the peace, or for any muni ci pal of fice at any general el ection hel dinthis state, and no candi date for the muni cipal or county office receives a maj ority of the votes cast for the office, there shall be a runoff general el ection hel d in that county or muni ci pality three (3) weeks following the date of the general el ection at whi ch the names of the two (2) candi dates recei ving the hi ghest number of votes, but not a majority, shall be placed on the ball ot to be voted upon by the qual ified el ectors of the county or the mini cipality, as the case may be. In the event two (2) candi dates recei ve the hi ghest number of votes and recei ve the same number of votes, a tie shall be deemed to exi st and the names of the tho (2) candi dates shall be placed on the ballot to be voted upon by the qual ified el ect ors of the county or the munici pality, as the case may be. If there is one (1) candi date whi ch recei ves the hi ghest number of votes,
but not a majority of the votes and two (2) ot her candi dates recei ve the same number of votes for the next hi ghest number of votes cast, a tie shall be deemed to exist bet ween the two (2) candi dates. The County Board of El ection Commissioners, at a public meeting and in the presence of the two (2) candi dates shall determine the runoff candi date by lot. The person recei ving the maj ority of the votes cast for the office at the runoff gener al el ection shal l be declared el ected. However, in the event the two (2) candi dates seeking el ection to the same county or muni cipal office shall recei ve the same number of votes in the runoff election, a tie shall be deemed to exist, and the county board of el ection commissioners, at an open public meeting, and in the presence of the two (2) candi dates, shall determine the wi nner by lot."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the act which can be given effect without the i nval id provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All laws and parts of I aws in conflict with this act are her eby repeal ed.
