12 EDUCATION DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
13 30, 2001; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - QUIZ BOWL. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
25 Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from the  
26 Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for costs associated with  
27 the Quiz Bowl by the Department of Education - General Education Division for  
28 the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

34 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ODYSSEY OF THE MIND. There is hereby  
35 appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to  
36 be payable from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for

1 grants not to exceed \$1,000 each to each student, school and adult chaperone  
2 representing Arkansas at the Odyssey Of The Mind World Championships for the  
3 biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

9 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE  
10 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AETN DOCUMENTED  
11 QUIZ BOWL COSTS. Of the total amount of appropriation and funds authorized  
12 herein to the Department of Education - General Education Division for the  
13 Quiz Bowl each fiscal year, an amount not to exceed 40% each fiscal year may  
14 be made available to the Department of Education - Educational Television  
15 Division for its documented costs associated with the Quiz Bowl.

17 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by  
18 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
19 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions  
20 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures  
21 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and  
22 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
23 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
24 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
25 with in disbursement of said funds.

27 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
34 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

36 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3  
4 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
5 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
6 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
7 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
8 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

9  
10 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
11 this act are hereby repealed.

12  
13 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
14 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
15 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
16 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of  
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the  
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
