## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. REGULAR SALARI ES - OPERATI ONS. There is her eby establ ished for the Arkansas State Uni versity for the 1999-2001 bi enni um the following maxi mum number of regul ar employees whose sal aries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Cl assification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual sal ary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt fromthe provisions of said UniformCl assification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herei $n$ are hereby governed by the provisions of $t$ he Regul ar Sal aries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTI ON 5. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL

ALLOMANCES. For the purpose of provi ding necessary allowances for housing and ot her unusual expenses incurred by or in behal $f$ of the athletic director, assi stant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at Arkansas St ate Uni versity, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances available ther ef or in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in vi ew of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic di rector, assi stant athletic di rectors, head coaches, and assi stant coaches, and for the purpose of provi ding such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend fromthe auxiliary income of the Arkansas St ate Uni versity, which is derived from athl etic event recei pts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars $(\$ 20,000)$ in the aggregate for such purposes during each year of the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni umfor the at hl et ic di rect or and head coaches, and ten thousand dollars $(\$ 10,000)$ in the aggregate for such purposes during the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni umfor the assistant at hl et ic di rectors and assistant coaches. Provi ded that any such allowances shal be in addition to the regul ar sal ary of such athletic director, assistant at hl et c di rectors, head coaches and assi stant coaches, as establ ished herei $n$ provi ded that the amount of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars ( $\$ 10,000$ ) per annumfor any one sal aried position. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized Arkansas State Uni versity shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact di sposition of the those special allowance funds authorized herein.

## SECTI ON 6. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

 NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW REALLOCATI ON OF RESOURCES. Upon det ermination by the President of Arkansas State Uni versity $t$ hat a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or consol i dation of admi ni strative functions within the uni versity is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the uni versity, the president, with approval of the Arkansas State Uni versity Board of Trustees, may have the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and rel ated funds between campuses, di visi ons, branches, and ot her budget ary units of Arkansas State Uni versity. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used for those purposes for whi ch the appropriations were approved by the Gener al Assembly. The transfers, consol idation, or reorganization whi ch i nvol ve academi c prograns shall be revi ewed by the Department of Hi gher Education andthe Legi sl ative Council.


#### Abstract

SECTI ON 7. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW LEASES.

Not wi thstanding any law to the contrary, the Board of Trustees of Arkansas State Uni versity may her eafter lease facilities or operations for room and board purposes in any manner and upon terms the board deems to be in the best interest of the uni versity. Action taken under this act shall be by written resol ution adopted by at least a maj ority of the members of the board.


SECTI ON 8. COMPLI ANCE W TH OTHER LAVB. Di sbur sement of funds aut horized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budget ary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regul ar Sal ary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Hi gher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regul ations promul gated by the Department of Fi nance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in di sbursement of said funds.

SECTI ON 9. LEGI SLATI VE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds di sbursed under the authority of the appropriations cont ai ned in this act shall be in compl iance with the stated reasons for whi ch this act was adopted, as evi denced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legi sl ative Recommendations contai ned in the budget manual s prepared by the Department of Fi nance and Admini stration, l et ters, or summarized or al testimy in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee whi ch rel ate to its passage and adoption.

SECTI ON 10. CODE. Al I provisions of this Act of a gener al and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annot at ed and the Arkansas Code Revisi on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 11. SEVERABI LITY. If any provi si on of $t$ hi $s$ act or the appl ication thereof to any person or circumstance is hel dinvalid, such inval idity shall
not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is her eby found and determined by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohi bits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1 , 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extensi on of the Regul ar Session, the del ay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper adm nistration and provision of essential governmental prograns. Ther ef ore, an emergency is hereby decl ared to exi st and this Act being necessary for the i meedi ate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect fromand after July 1, 1999.
