19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) The directors of a school district and school employees
22 and volunteers may employ reasonable force in instances in which an individual
23 threatens the safety of any other individual during a school activity.

24 (b) The directors of a school district and school employees and
25 volunteers shall not be criminally or civilly liable for the use of reasonable
26 force in instances in which an individual threatens the safety of any other
27 individual during a school activity.
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
