The unexpended balances of appropriation provided for the expenditures of federal funds as provided for in Section 5 of this Act on June 30, 1998 2000, shall be carried forward and made available for expenditures for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999 2001.

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SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item appropriation authorized in Section 5 of this Act to any other line item authorized in Section 4 of this Act to any other line item authorized in Section 4 of this Act.

There is hereby established a pool of thirteen (13) positions entitled State Economic Developer III to be assigned to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission which will be used to reclassify personnel from State Economic Developer I and/or State Economic Developer II. To obtain a position from the pool, the Arkansas Economic Development Commission must seek a review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, obtain approval from the Office of Personnel Management and must surrender the position being reclassified to the pool. SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CAPITAL EQUIPMENT. In addition to training expenses, funds made available to support the appropriation in Item (06) of Section 16 for INDUSTRY TRAINING PROGRAM EXPENSES herein shall be used to acquire capital equipment necessary to enhance the quick-start capabilities of the Arkansas Industry Training Programs. When not in use in an AITP managed course of training, the equipment shall be stored at a location to be determined by the Executive Director, AEDC.

SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOREIGN OFFICE OPERATIONS. The Arkansas <u>Economic</u> Development Office is hereby authorized to enter into contractual arrangements with private and/or public

- 17 DEVELOPMENT. From the funds appropriated for COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANTS in
- 18 <u>this Act for Community Assistance-Federal</u>, the Arkansas Economic Development
- 19 Commission (AEDC) shall allocate \$500,000 per fiscal year to the Rural

- 36 The Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC) shall review all

Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 41. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 42. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 43. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall

1	not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
2	effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
3	provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
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5	SECTION 44. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
6	this act are hereby repealed.
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8	SECTION 45. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
9	Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
10	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
11	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
15	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
