- (c) The Advisory Committee on Accountability established in § 6-15-804 as the citizens' advisory committee on accountability in education for this state shall also assist the Office of Accountability in the performance of its duties under this chapter.
- (d) The annual report provided under § 6-15-809 shall include any findings and recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Accountability concerning two-year postsecondary educational programs in this state.
- (e) Establishment of the Office of Accountability and implementation of the provisions of this section which directly affect the operation of the Department of Higher Education shall be contingent on the appropriation and funding of the staff and operating budget necessary to allow the department to carry out the duties assigned to the department in this chapter.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-61-901 is amended to read as follows: "6-61-901 Purpose.

In order to enhance the public's access to performance indicators and to better measure the dividends paid on the increasing public investment in Arkansas' institutions of higher education, the General Assembly finds that a separate office of accountability should be established within the Department of Higher Education. The foremost obligation of this office shall be to publish annual campus-by-campus assessments, noting student achievement and research accomplishments and providing information to set future performance goals for each campus. A coequal obligation of this office is to be accurate and open with the department, the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education of the General Assembly, the Joint Interim Oversight Subcommittee on Education Reform, and the public."

- 31 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-61-902 is amended to read as follows:
- 32 6-61-902. Creation Coordinator and staff. Office of accountability 33 with the Department of Higher Education.
 - "(a) There is created the Office of Accountability within the Department of Higher Education.
- 36 (b) The Director of the Department of Higher Education shall establish

a coordinator and staff for the Office of Accountability. The Office of 1 2 Accountability is authorized and directed to collect and analyze information 3 that may be required to meet any state or federal requirement. (c) Under the direction of the Director of the Department of Higher 4 5 Education, the staff of the Office of Accountability shall work cooperatively with and provide any necessary assistance to the House and Senate Interim 6 7 Committees on Education." 8 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 6-61-903 is repealed. 9 6-61-903. Duties. 10 The Office of Accountability shall have the following duties: 11 12 (1) Beginning in 1992, to issue an annual report on the results of an overall study of accountability measures in higher education; 13 (2) To develop and publish results of a campus-by-campus 14 assessment program of student achi evement and research accomplishments; 15 (3) Using funds authorized by this subchapter and appropriated 16 17 for this purpose, to make demonstration project grants to at least one (1) public four-year and one (1) public two-year institution in order to develop 18 model institutional assessment programs which will serve as pilots for other 19 colleges and universities in the state. The Department of Higher Education is 20 authorized to develop rules and procedures for selecting demonstration 21 22 projects and awarding grants for this purpose; (4) To administer a "rising junior" test designed to test 23 24 students' abilities to satisfactorily perform upper level course requirements 25 and publish results of the test; (5) To work with institutions of higher education to develop 26 27 common instruments used by the institutions to measure iob placement, iob retention, and wage rates for recent graduates and nongraduating students, and 28 to measure student satisfaction by graduates and nongraduating students with 29 30 their education experience, and to report results to the Department of Higher 31 Education for publication: (6) To compare the performance of Arkansas college graduates with 32 33 graduates from other states, based on measures such as scores on Graduate Record Exams, the Law School Admissions Test, Graduate Management Admissions 34 Test, National Teachers Exam, and Medical College Admissions Test and publish 35 36 these results:
