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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-53-204 is repealed.

23 ~~(a) The Office of Accountability of the Department of Higher Education~~
24 ~~shall have the following duties in regard to the technical and community~~
25 ~~colleges:-~~

26 ~~(1) To study the effectiveness of the delivery of postsecondary~~
27 ~~education following the conversions, mergers, and consolidations under this~~
28 ~~chapter;-~~

29 ~~(2) To assess institutions in the area of student achievement;-~~

18 "6-61-901 Purpose.

19 In order to enhance the public's access to performance indicators and to
 20 better measure the dividends paid on the increasing public investment in
 21 Arkansas' institutions of higher education, the General Assembly finds that a
 22 separate office of accountability should be established within the Department
 23 of Higher Education. ~~The foremost obligation of this office shall be to~~
 24 ~~publish annual campus-by-campus assessments, noting student achievement and~~
 25 ~~research accomplishments and providing information to set future performance~~
 26 ~~goals for each campus. A coequal obligation of this office is to be accurate~~
 27 ~~and open with the department, the House and Senate Interim Committees on~~
 28 ~~Education of the General Assembly, the Joint Interim Oversight Subcommittee on~~
 29 ~~Education Reform, and the public."~~

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 31 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-61-902 is amended to read as follows:

32 6-61-902. ~~Creation -- Coordinator and staff.~~ Office of accountability
 33 with the Department of Higher Education.

34 "(a) There is created the Office of Accountability within the
 35 Department of Higher Education.

36 (b) ~~The Director of the Department of Higher Education shall establish~~

1 ~~a coordinator and staff for the Office of Accountability. The Office of~~
 2 ~~Accountability is authorized and directed to collect and analyze information~~
 3 ~~that may be required to meet any state or federal requirement.~~

4 (c) Under the direction of the Director of the Department of Higher
 5 Education, the staff of the Office of Accountability shall work cooperatively
 6 with and provide any necessary assistance to the House and Senate Interim
 7 Committees on Education."

11 ~~The Office of Accountability shall have the following duties:~~

12 ~~(1) Beginning in 1992, to issue an annual report on the results~~
 13 ~~of an overall study of accountability measures in higher education;~~

14 ~~(2) To develop and publish results of a campus-by-campus~~
 15 ~~assessment program of student achievement and research accomplishments;~~

16 ~~(3) Using funds authorized by this subchapter and appropriated~~
 17 ~~for this purpose, to make demonstration project grants to at least one (1)~~
 18 ~~public four-year and one (1) public two-year institution in order to develop~~
 19 ~~model institutional assessment programs which will serve as pilots for other~~
 20 ~~colleges and universities in the state. The Department of Higher Education is~~
 21 ~~authorized to develop rules and procedures for selecting demonstration~~
 22 ~~projects and awarding grants for this purpose;~~

23 ~~(4) To administer a "rising junior" test designed to test~~
 24 ~~students' abilities to satisfactorily perform upper level course requirements~~
 25 ~~and publish results of the test;~~

26 ~~(5) To work with institutions of higher education to develop~~
 27 ~~common instruments used by the institutions to measure job placement, job~~
 28 ~~retention, and wage rates for recent graduates and nongraduating students, and~~
 29 ~~to measure student satisfaction by graduates and nongraduating students with~~
 30 ~~their education experience, and to report results to the Department of Higher~~

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31 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

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5 SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.

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
