## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE SECTI ON 8-5-209 WASTEWATER TREATMENT LI CENSI NG FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

Subtitle<br>"AN ACT TO AMEND THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT LI CENSI NG FEES. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 8-5-209(a) is amended to read as follows:
"(a)(1) The Eomission Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecol ogy
Commission shall have the authority to set fees in an amount to cover the cost of $t$ he admi ni stration of $t$ hi s subchapter. These fees shall not exceed twentyfive dollars (\$25.00) for exam nation, ten dollars (\$10.00) for licensing, and ten dollars $(\$ 10.00)$ for annual renewal of licenses.
(2) Li censing and exami nation fees shall be set forth in the regul ation; however, they shall not exceed:
(A) A combi ned exami nation and license fee of forty dollars
(\$40.00) ; and
(B) An annual license renewal fee of twenty dollars
(\$20.00)."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ his act of a general and permant nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of Iaws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
