9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED
10 WITH THE STUDY, PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF NEEDED
11 IMPROVEMENTS OR PROJECTS OR BOTH ALONG THE MAIN STEM
12 OF THE OUACHITA RIVER FOR THE SOIL AND WATER
13 CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING
14 JUNE 30, 2001; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Soil and
26 Water Conservation Commission, to be payable from the Ouachita River Waterways
27 Project Trust Fund, for costs associated with the study, planning and
28 implementation of needed improvements or projects or both along the main stem
29 of the Ouachita River of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission for the
30 biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the sum of\$1,000,000.
31

32 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
33 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GENERAL
34 IMPROVEMENT FUND TRANSFER. When funds are authorized to be made available
35 through the provisions of the General Improvement Distribution Act of 1999 for
36 the Ouachita River Study, Planning and Implementation Project herein and upon

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1 meeting all other conditions as set out by law, the Chief Fiscal Officer of
2 the State and State Treasurer shall transfer the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much
3 thereof as is made available therefrom, from the General Improvement Fund or
4 its fund account to the Ouachita River Waterways Project Trust Fund there to
5 be used for such purposes as appropriated herein.

6
7 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
8 this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
9 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
10 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
11 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
12 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
13 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
14 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
15 with in disbursement of said funds.

16
17 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
18 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
19 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
24 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
27 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
28 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29
30 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
31 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
32 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
33 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
34 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

36 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with

1 this Act are hereby repealed.

2
3 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Eighty-second General Assembly, that when Congress authorizes a project for
5 the improvement of the main stem of the Ouachita river in Clark, Ouachita,
6 Calhoun, Union, Bradley and Ashley counties in Arkansas state funds need to be
7 available immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
8 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
9 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1,
10 1999.
