SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 13 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 FOOD SERVICE. 15 If the University of Central Arkansas cancels the current contract for food 16 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to utilize 17 18 the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided he or 19 she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and the 20 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the Arkansas 21 Legislative Council.

22

23 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 24 SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas may 25 26 make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year for any one 27 28 coach during each year of the <del>1997-99</del> 1999-2001 biennium. Further, if the 29 special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, the University of 30 Central Arkansas shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing 31 Committee the exact disposition of those special allowance funds.

32

33 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 34 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 35 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 36 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 8 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 11 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 14 15 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

21 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application 22 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall 23 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given 24 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 25 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

26

27 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 28 this act are hereby repealed.

30 SECTION 12. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is hereby found and determined by the 31 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas 32 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that 33 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the

1	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
2	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
