9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 23-89-203 TO PROVIDE
10 FOR THE REJECTION OF CERTAIN AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY
11 INSURANCE ON A FORM APPROVED BY THE INSURANCE
12 COMMISSIONER WHICH CONTAINS AN ESTIMATE OF THE COST OF
13 THE COVERAGE REJECTED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-89-203 is amended to read as follows:

26 "23-89-203. Rejection of coverage.

27 (a) The named insured shall have the right to reject in writing all or
28 any one (1) or more of the coverages enumerated in § 23-89-202 provided that
29 such rejection is done on a form approved by the Commissioner, which form
30 shall provide a reasonable estimate of the cost of the coverage rejected.

31 (b) After a named insured or applicant for insurance rejects this
32 coverage, the insurer or any of its affiliates shall not be required to notify
33 any insured in any renewal, reinstatement, substitute, amended, or replacement
34 policy as to the availability of such coverage."

36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3
4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
