22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-11-206(2) is amended to read as follows:

25 "(2) 'Local public procurement unit' means any county, city, town,
26 state agency, and any other subdivision of the state or public agency thereof;
27 any fire protection district; regional water distribution district; rural
28 development authority; any public authority; any public educational, health,
29 or other institution; any nonprofit corporation during such time that it
30 contracts with ~~the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services of the~~
31 ~~Arkansas Department of Human Services to provide services to the~~
32 ~~developmentally disabled~~ any division of the Department of Human Services,
33 provided such contract exceeds seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) per
34 year; any nonprofit corporation providing fire protection services to a rural
35 area or providing drinking water to the public in a rural area; and, to the
36 extent not prohibited by law, any other entity which expends public funds for

1 the acquisition or leasing of commodities and services;"

2
3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6
7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
