19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-101-103(4) is amended to read as follows:

22 "27-101-103. Definitions.

23 (4) 'Waters of this state' means ~~any public waters within the~~
24 ~~territorial limits of the State of Arkansas~~ all streams, lakes, ponds, sloughs,
25 bayous, marshes, or other waters, wholly or in part within this state.
26 Provided, that waters which are confined within a pond, tank, or lake,
27 situated entirely on the premises of a single owner and which, except under
28 abnormal flood conditions, are in no way connected by water or with any other
29 flowing stream or body of water, or with any other body of water not situated
30 on the premises of the owner, are declared to be privately owned waters and
31 shall not be construed to be included in the expression 'waters of this
32 state';"

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
