## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Arkansas Code 9-9-102(d) pertaining to adoption is amended to read as follows:
"(d) The court shall not deny a petition for adoption on the basis of race, color, or national origin of the adoptive parent or the child invol ved so long as the adoptive parent is a citizen of the United States or has met all standards set out by the U.S. Department of I mingration and Nat uralization (INS) required for international adoptions."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permnent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of Iaws in conflict with this Act are hereby repeal ed.
