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## For An Act To Be Entitled

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"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR VARIOUS MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

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## Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER - VARIOUS MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY PROJECTS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION. "

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - VARIOUS MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY PROJECTS.

24 *There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration*  
25 *- Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its*  
26 *successor fund or fund accounts, the following:*

27 (A) *For the City of Forrest City, Arkansas for renovation and repair of the*  
28 *J. H. King Community Center, the sum..... 100,000.*

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30 (B) *For the City of Earle, Arkansas for renovation land acquisition for a*  
31 *new city hall, the sum of ..... \$50,000.*

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33 (C) *For the City of Horseshoe Lake for municipal infrastructure projects*  
34 *including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction*  
35 *and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the*  
36 *sum of ..... \$75,000.*

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(D) For the City of Hughes for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum of ..... \$50,000.

(E) For the City of Madison for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum of ..... \$50,000.

(F) For the City of Haynes for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum of ..... \$50,000.

(G) For the City of Crawfordsville for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum of..... \$50,000.

(H) For the City of Edmondson for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum of ..... \$50,000.

(I) For the City of Edmondson, to be used exclusively for infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of public buildings in the Anthonyville community, the sum of ..... \$50,000.

(J) For the City of Rondo, to be used for municipal infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of public buildings, the sum of ..... \$25,000.

1 (K) For the City of LaGrange, to be used for municipal infrastructure  
2 projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street  
3 construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of public  
4 buildings, the sum of .....\$25,000.

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6 (L) For the City of Lakeview, Arkansas, to be used for municipal  
7 infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water  
8 improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and  
9 renovation of public buildings, the sum of .....\$50,000.

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11 (M) For the City of Aubrey, Arkansas, to be used for municipal  
12 infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water  
13 improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and  
14 renovation of public buildings, the sum of .....\$25,000.

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16 SECTION 2. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. There is hereby  
17 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration, to be payable  
18 from the Indigent Patient's Fund, the following:

19 (A) For operational support for Mid-South Community College, the sum of  
20 .....\$125,000.

21 (B) For the Delta Research Education Development Foundation for parks and  
22 recreational projects in the City of West Memphis, Arkansas, the sum of  
23 .....\$250,000.

24 (C) For the City of Turrell, Arkansas, for school renovations, the sum of  
25 .....\$25,000.

26 (D) For Emergency Medical Services in Cross, Mississippi, Lee, Poinsett,  
27 and St. Francis Counties, in equal amounts, a sum not to exceed .  
28 .....\$100,000.

29 (E) For operational support of the East Arkansas Family Health Center, the  
30 sum of .....\$50,000.

31 (F) For operations, maintenance, and equipment for the Steudlein Learning  
32 Center in Crittenden County, the sum of .....\$23,000.

33 (G) For a grant to be divided equally between the cities of Gilmore and  
34 Turrell, a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

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36 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
 2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
 3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
 4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
 5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
 6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
 7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
 8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
 9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
 10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
 11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
 13 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
 14 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
 15 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
 16 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
 17 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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 19 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION – CEMETERY RESTORATION. There is hereby  
 20 appropriated to the Department of Finance and Administration – Disbursing  
 21 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund  
 22 or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage for grants for the  
 23 restoration of cemeteries in Lee, Phillips, and St. Francis County, the sum of  
 24 .....\$100,000.

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 26 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 31 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
 33 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 35 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 36 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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3 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
4 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
5 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
6 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
7 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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9 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
10 this act are hereby repealed.

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12 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
13 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
14 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
15 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of  
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the  
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
