19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Any person who pumps fuel into a vehicle or container, which
22 fuel is the property of a retail business entity which engages in the sale of
23 fuel, then leaves the premises with the fuel and without paying for the fuel,
24 shall, during the four (4) hours following the event, be subject to arrest,
25 notwithstanding the lack of a warrant for the arrest. Provided, however, the
26 person arrested shall be released within twenty four (24) hours of the arrest
27 unless a warrant for the arrest of the person is issued according to law.
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
