# For An Act To Be Entitled <br> "AN ACT TO PROVI DE FOR THE ARREST OF PERSONS WHO PUMP <br> FUEL AND FAI L TO PAY FOR IT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. " 


#### Abstract

Subtitle "AN ACT TO PROVI DE FOR THE ARREST OF PERSONS WHO PUMP FUEL AND FAI L TO PAY FOR IT."


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Any person who pumps fuel into a vehicle or contai ner, whi ch fuel is the property of a retail busi ness entity whi ch engages in the sale of fuel, then leaves the premses with the fuel and without paying for the fuel, shall, during the four (4) hours following the event, be subject to arrest, not withstanding the lack of a warrant for the arrest. Provided, however, the person arrested shall be rel eased within twenty four (24) hours of the arrest unl ess a warrant for the arrest of the person is issued according to law.

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of this act of a gener al and permanent nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is hel d i nval id, such i nval idity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the act which can be given effect wi hout the i nval id provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All I aws and parts of Iaws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
