For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR WITHHOLDING MONEYS WAGERED AT
10 FRANCHISED DOG RACING FACILITIES TO PAY AS PURSES TO
11 GREYHOUND OWNERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. From the amount withheld and retained by the dog-racing
22 franchise holder on all live greyhound racing and greyhound racing
23 performances simultaneously televised by the franchise holder but conducted at
24 another race track, the franchise holder shall set aside four and three-
25 eighths percent (4.375%) from the moneys wagered at the franchised facility
26 for purses to pay to the greyhound owners who race at that facility. From the
27 amount withheld and retained by the dog-racing franchise holder on all horse
28 racing performances simultaneously televised by the franchise holder, the
29 franchise holder shall set aside one and three-fourths percent (1.75%) from
30 the moneys wagered at the franchised facility for purses to pay to the
31 greyhound owners who race at that facility. These set asides shall be addition
32 to any other credits or payments made by the dog-racing franchise holder in
33 accordance to law.
34

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
