There is hereby authorized, for the Office of Inspector General for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: 0 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

3	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
