If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 31 act are declared to be severable.

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33 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 34 hereby repealed.

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
