20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-27-204 is amended to read as follows:

23 "5-27-204. Endangering welfare of minor - Second degree.

24 (a) A person commits the offense of endangering the welfare of a minor
25 in the second degree if he knowingly engages in conduct creating a substantial
26 risk of serious harm to the physical or mental welfare of one known by the
27 actor to be a minor including acts of domestic abuse as defined in § 16-81-
28 113.

29 (b) Endangering the welfare of a minor in the second degree is a Class
30 A misdemeanor."

31
32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35
36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

5
6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
