17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-64-214 is amended to read as follows:
20 "5-64-214. Criteria for Schedule VI.

21 The director shall place a substance in Schedule VI if he finds that:

22 (a) The substance is not currently accepted for medical use in
23 treatment in the United States;

24 (b) That there is lack of accepted safety for use of the drug or other
25 substance even under direct medical supervision; and

26 (c) That the substance has relatively high psychological and/or
27 physiological dependence liability; and or that use of the substance presents
28 a definite risk to public health.

29 ~~(d) That use of the substance presents a definite risk to public~~
30 ~~health."~~

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
