19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-4-309(f) is amended to read as follows:	
20	"(f) If the court revokes a suspension or probation, it may enter a	
21	judgment of conviction and may impose any sentence on the defendant that mig	ght
22	have been imposed originally for the offense of which he was found guilty,	
23	provided that any sentence to pay a fine or to imprisonment when combined w	i th
24	any previous fine or imprisonment imposed for the same offense shall not	
25	exceed the limits of § 5-4-201 or § 5-4-401, or, if applicable, § 5-4-501.	
26	PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE TERM "ANY SENTENCE" INCLUDES THE EXTENSION	OF
27	A PERIOD OF SUSPENSION OR PROBATION. IF UPON REVOCATION, AN EXTENSION OF	
28	SUSPENSION OR PROBATION IS MADE, THE COURT IS NOT DEPRIVED OF THE ABILITY TO	
29	REVOKE SUCH SUSPENSION OR PROBATION AGAIN, SHOULD THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT SO	<u>0</u>

32	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nat	
33	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code	
34	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to	0

any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
