20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

SECTION 1. Operating expenses - Staff.

22
23 (a) The Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of the Twenty-second
24 Judicial District shall receive not less than a contingent expense
25 reimbursement for the expenses of the office including, but not limited to,
26 maintenance and operation, capital outlay, office supplies, telephone,
27 postage, copying, insurance, and library in the following amounts to be borne
28 Saline County of the of the Twenty-second Judicial District in the amount of
29 forty-seven thousand, three hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$47,359).

30 (b) Saline County shall pay the authorized annual amounts in equal
31 quarterly installments from the county general fund and the checks shall be
32 made payable to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney. Disbursements shall be
33 made by the Prosecuting Attorney for the necessary expenses of the office
34 based upon adequate documentation.

35 (c) The prosecuting attorney or deputies may also be allowed additional
36 expenses upon appropriation of the quorum court and approval of the county

1 judge.

2 (d) The Prosecuting Attorney of the Twenty-second Judicial District
3 shall be entitled to the following assistants and employees:

4 (1) One (1) chief deputy prosecuting attorney, whose salary shall
5 not be less than fifty-five thousand, two hundred dollars (\$55,200) per annum.

6 The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll
7 policy for county employees of Saline County. In addition to the salary,
8 social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all related salary
9 expenses shall be paid by Saline County;

10 (2) One (1) deputy prosecuting attorney, whose salary shall not
11 be less than forty-four thousand, seven hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$44, 758)
12 per annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and
13 payroll policy for county employees of Saline County. In addition to the
14 salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all related
15 salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County;

16 (3) One (1) deputy prosecuting attorney, whose salary shall not
17 be less than forty-two thousand, two hundred twenty-four dollars (\$42,224) per
18 annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll
19 policy for county employees of Saline County. In addition to the salary,
20 social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all related salary
21 expenses shall be paid by Saline County;

22 (4) One (1) deputy prosecuting attorney, whose salary shall not
23 be less than thirty-eight thousand, three hundred ninety-nine dollars
24 (\$38,399) per annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay
25 periods and payroll policy for county employees of Saline County. In addition
26 to the salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all
27 related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County;

28 (5) One (1) deputy prosecuting attorney, whose salary shall not
29 be less than twenty-nine thousand, seven hundred thirty-four dollars (\$29,734)
30 per annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and
31 payroll policy for county employees of Saline County. In addition to the
32 salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all related
33 salary expenses may be paid by Saline County.

34 (6) One, (1) deputy prosecuting attorney for Saline County whose
35 salary shall not be less than thirty-five thousand, seven hundred thirty-four
36 dollars (\$35,734) per annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the

1 pay periods and payroll policy for county employees of Saline County. In
2 addition to the salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and
3 all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County;

4 (7) One (1) victim/witness director, whose salary shall not be
5 less than twenty-four thousand five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$24,548) per
6 annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll
7 policy of Saline County. In addition to the salary, social security, matching
8 retirement, insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline
9 County;

10 (8) One (1) victim/witness coordinator, whose salary shall not be
11 less than twenty-one thousand, three hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$21,378)
12 per annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and
13 payroll policy of Saline County. In addition to the salary, social security,
14 matching retirement, insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid
15 by Saline County;

16 (9) One (1) office manager, whose salary shall not be less than
17 twenty-two thousand, nine hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$22,997) per annum.
18 The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy
19 of Saline County. In addition to the salary, social security, matching
20 retirement, insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline
21 County; and

22 (10) One (1) hot check coordinator, whose salary shall not be
23 less than nineteen thousand, six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$19,625) per
24 annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll
25 policy of Saline County. In addition to the salary, social security, matching
26 retirement, insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline
27 County.

28 (11) One (1) lead secretary, whose salary shall not be less than
29 fifteen thousand, five hundred fifty dollars (\$15,550) per annum. The salary
30 is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Saline
31 County. In addition to the salary, social security, matching retirement,
32 insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County.

33 (12) One (1) secretary, whose salary shall not be less than
34 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) per annum. The salary is to be paid in
35 accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Saline County. In
36 addition to the salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and

1 all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County.

2 (13) One (1) part-time secretary, whose salary shall not be less
3 than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum. The salary is to be paid in
4 accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Saline County. In
5 addition to the salary, social security, matching retirement, insurance, and
6 all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline County.

7 (14) One (1) part-time victim/witness coordinator, whose salary
8 shall not be less than eleven thousand, four hundred dollars (\$11,400) per
9 annum. The salary is to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and payroll
10 policy of Saline County. In addition to the salary, social security, matching
11 retirement, insurance, and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Saline
12 County.

13 (15) The prosecuting attorney of the Twenty-second Judicial
14 District shall be allowed additional assistance and employees in each county
15 upon appropriation of the quorum court and approval of the county judge in
16 each respective county.

17
18 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
19 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
20 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

21
22 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
23 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
24 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
26 act are declared to be severable.

28 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
29 hereby repealed.
